NOTE: DISQUALIFICATION FROM SERVICE AS A GOVERNOR

Appointment as a governor is subject to certain regulations which disqualify persons from becoming governors. Those not eligible to serve in this capacity are:-

- (a) Any person serving on more than two governing bodies (membership of a temporary governing body does not count towards this total);
- (b) Any person under 18 years of age;
- (c) Any person convicted (within the last 5 years) of a crime which carries a penalty of three months or more imprisonment without the option of a fine;
- (d) Any person convicted (within the last 20 years) of a crime which carries a penalty of two and a half years or more imprisonment;
- (e) Any person convicted of a crime which carries a penalty of not less than five years or more imprisonment;
- (f) Any person convicted under Section 547 of The Education Act 1996 of Section 85A of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992 (nuisance and disturbance on education premises) and has been sentenced to a fine;
- (g) Any person declared bankrupt - until discharged from bankruptcy;
- (h) Any person disqualified from serving as a Company Director;
- (i) Any person who has been removed from a position as a trustee for a Charity on the grounds of misconduct or mismanagement;
- (j) Any person who is prohibited or restricted in respect of employment with children or young persons;
- (k) Any person liable to be detained (sectioned) under the Mental Health Act 1983;
- (l) Any person disqualified from being a proprietor, teacher or other employee at an independent school;
- (m) Any person who refuses a request by the governing body to make an application for a criminal records certificate;
- (n) Any person who has been disqualified for non-attendance within the preceding year.
